National Environment Protection Agency - NEPA, public institution with legal personality, financed from the state budget, shall be entered in the context of EU and international cooperation, in order to defend principles and implement the legislation in the field of environmental protection.

Having a good understanding of the cooperation need, of the environmental representation in internal and external relations, NEPA monitors the state meet environmental, according to NEPA's mandate, assumed by the implementation plans negotiated with the European Commission in the enlargement of EU.

Together with all other entities involved in the process of EU institutions reporting requests NEPA is the purpose of a watch meeting the objectives of reporting, in accordance with the Directives European Union, within the time limits and with the objectives set out in this respect.

As EEA Member of the Board representative, NEPA is having an important role at the European Environment Agency's meetings (EEA), as a member of board of management of the European Environment Agency together with representatives of the other agencies of the environment, but also of the countries which have the status of an observer in the work of European Environment Agency (e.g. Turkey).

The NEPA is part of international conferences, including at the highest level of representation in the secretariat of international conventions, such as from the date of January 01 2013, Romania holds the office of Chair position –Standing Committee of the Ramsar Convention for the period 2013 - 2015.

NEPA is represented at the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), through participation in the working groups HelpNet REACH and CLP, projects and programs, as well as in a series of training in the field of hazardous substances. More details on www.echa.europe.eu/

NEPA is at the same time, together with the National Focal point at the Ministry of Environment Water and Forests, equal responsible for submitting reports for different areas of environment expertise to European Environment Agency.

NEPA develops cooperation activities and cooperation with non-member countries of the EU, we note in this respect the Republic China, Turkey, Norway, Switzerland, by participating in events of large profile in the country and abroad, participating in bilateral projects. NEPA wishes the cooperation on an international level, indicating its availability and desire to share the experience in the field of environmental protection.
